#### An authentic street photographer's view of people in big cities

For the past decade, Zurich-based street and documentary photographer Jens Krauer has journeyed through some of the world's most exhilarating metropolises, immortalizing the everyday life that unfolds on the streets. This mission is brilliantly encapsulated in his debut book, *In Plain Sight. Candid Urban Encounters*.

Krauer has wandered through cities like Amsterdam, New York, and Paris on foot for hours and months, armed only with his camera and his preferred lens, to document the lives of those often overlooked by society. He turns his lens to the individuals who blend into the urban landscape, capturing "decisive moments." Tirelessly, empathetically, and openly, he portrays a full spectrum of emotions—depicting moments that are sad, intimate, life-changing, and humorously poignant. His authentic, unfiltered black-and-white photographs focus particularly on the spontaneous moments that get lost in the clamor of bustling city streets.

*In Plain Sight. Candid Urban Encounters* is a captivating, personal book about serendipitous meetings. It invites readers to immerse themselves in the stories and see the captured everyday moments from a fresh, unbiased perspective. Through his impressive work, Krauer embodies a new generation of visual storytellers and street photographers, drawing inspiration from the vibrant, dynamic life of the streets.

Jens Krauer's work vibrates with energy as much as it does with silence. As a street photographer he keeps his eyes wide open and so embraces the world. You are there, alongside the photographer, looking into a world both strange and familiar.

It's a face, a movement, a gesture, a juxtaposition.

There are stories here in every frame, inviting the viewer along to write their own. That's what engaging photography does. It begins the conversation. It does not end it. And so the world moves forward in time, while the photographer has stopped it if only for a frozen second, before it continues on.

Jens Krauer is a Zurich-based street and documentary photographer. His photography focuses on the everyday life of different cultures and has been exhibited throughout Europe and the United States. In addition to his exhibitions, Krauer offers street photography workshops and seminars where he teaches creative visual storytelling to aspiring and professional photographers.
